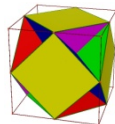

Your school teams are invited to attend for the 18th and 19th March when they will meet the UK teams and join us to explore the Cambridge Science Festival. The Festival is a free public event, organised by the University of Cambridge, which attracts around 40,000 visitors every year. Students can join in with the many hands-on science workshops, watch exciting demonstrations and attend talks by world leading researchers which aim to raise aspirations by encouraging young people to consider a career in science, technology, engineering or mathematics. The festival is free.

Away from the Festival, participating KIKS project students can explore and discuss issues of mutual scientific interest and concern, as well as taking part in social and cultural activities.

Accommodation recommendations are the Cambridge IBIS and Travel Lodge Hotels (both located near the Cambridge Station area) and we are also exploring other budget options.

Cambridge is an easy 30minute train ride from London STANSTED airport.

Finally, we congratulate you and your students on their contribution so far to the EU ERASMUS+ KIKS project and invite you to take this further with this valuable international learning experience in the centre of Cambridge.
